Kindly refer to the letter No. RUB/HRMD-14(B)/2009/1709 dated 11/04/09 regarding the following RUB officials who were convicted by the Royal Court of Justice, High Court:

1. Kesang Dendup Yeshey (EID No. 9108107), Lecturer; and
2. Phurba (EID No. 9507257), Asst. Lecturer

In this regard, the Royal Civil Service Commission during its 19th meeting held on June 23, 2009 reviewed the letter and after extensive deliberation decided to terminate the services of the above officials of the Paro College of Education with immediate effect.

The above decision has been reached based on the provisions of the BCSR 2006: sections 10.9 and 10.9.1 of Chapter 19 on Administrative Discipline rules and regulations since the above officials convicted by the Courts fall within offence degree of 'Misdemeanour', each of which carried a sentence of one year but less than 3 years, as per the Penal Code of Bhutan.

The Royal University of Bhutan is required to terminate the services of the above officials with immediate effect and they shall not be eligible for post retirement and other benefits, except one's own contribution. Kindly endorse copy of the termination orders to the RCSC.
